Finally, there are many design projects in China, but there is not much attention to the "growth" of a design. Currently, the design tends to focus only on the current and ignores the development after 10 years, 20 years, or even longer. How to keep up with the times, whether this paper can be used to cause all the attention to the development of the park is the third meaning of this article.

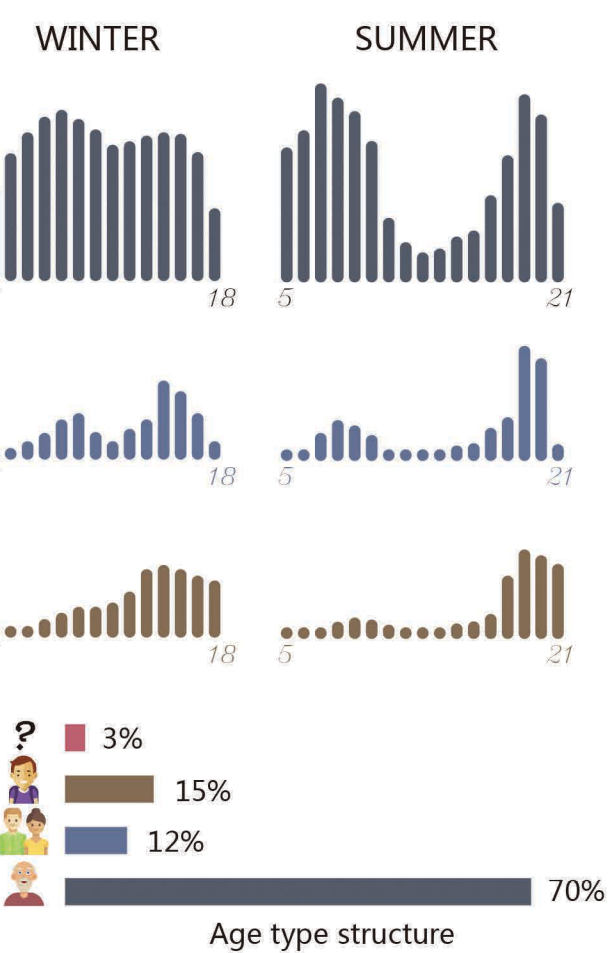

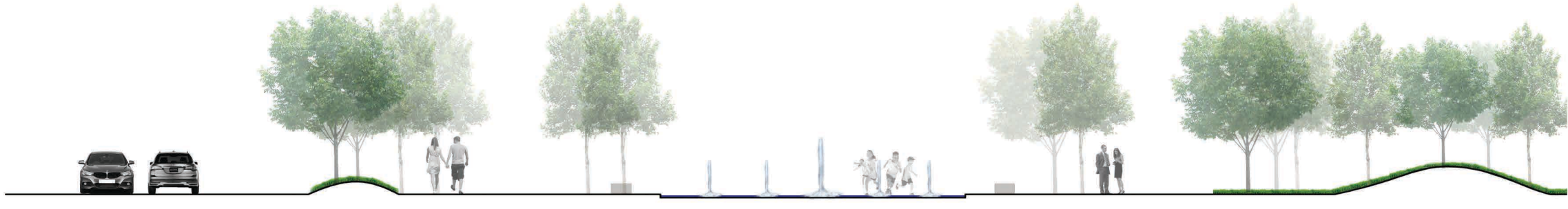
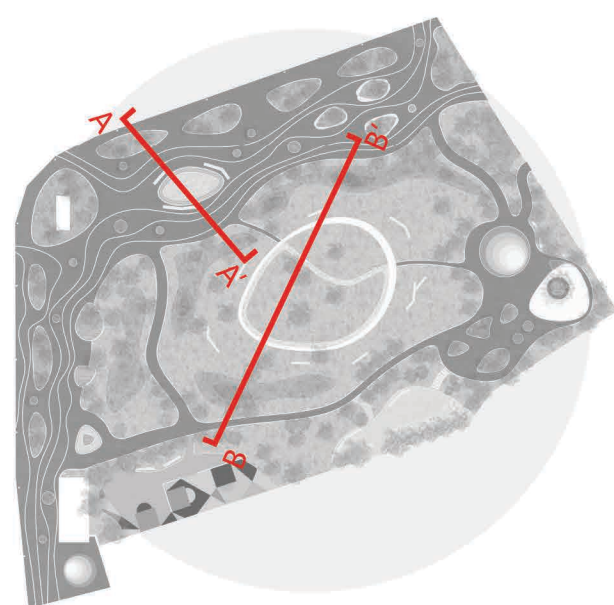


- I CENTER LOOP

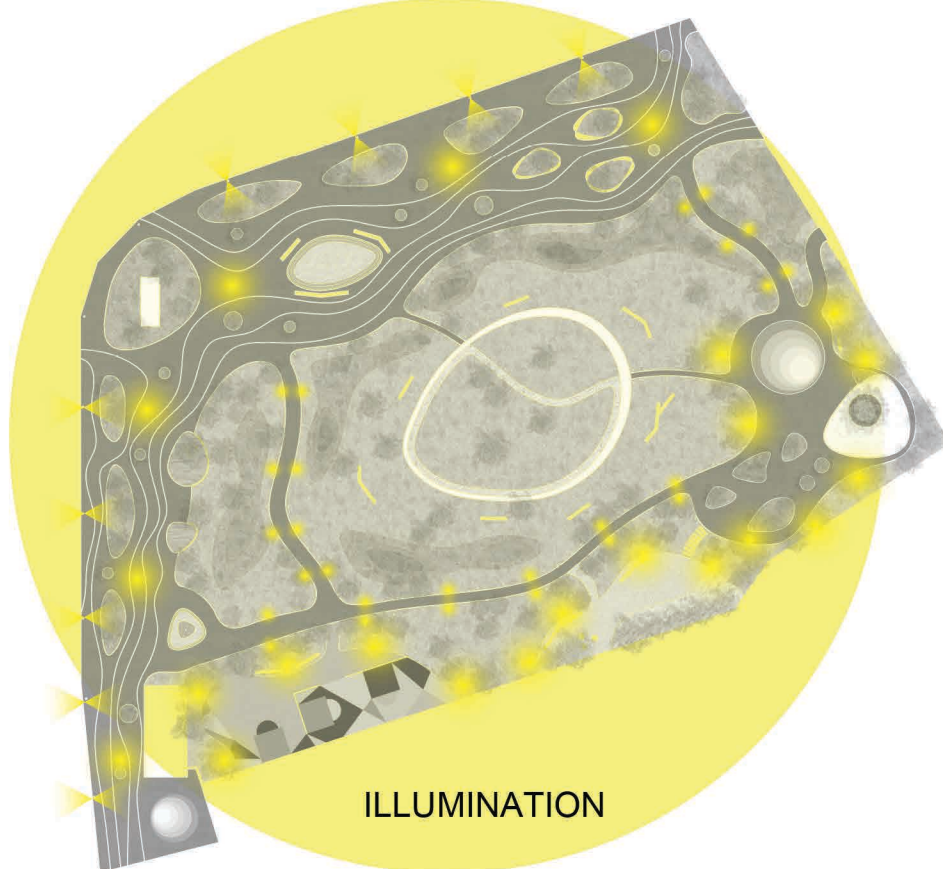
